Items Accepted:


- **Cleaning Products:** bleach, drain cleaners, floor polish, furniture polish, oven cleaners, rug and upholstery cleaners, rust removers, spot removers
- **Fluorescent Light Tubes and Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs**
- **Automotive Products:** antifreeze, brake fluid, cleaners, degreasers, fuels, motor oil, oil filters, waxes, windshield washer fluid
- **Cooking Oil:** (though not hazardous, this can be re-used)
- **Household Pesticides:** Weed killers, bug killers, fungicides
- **Paint:** Latex and oil, spray paint, stains
- **Rechargeable batteries of all types**


The following tips will make your visit to the Sac County Household Hazardous Waste Facility more efficient:


- Leave materials in their original containers.
- Be prepared to show your driver's license
- Be prepared to complete a short questionnaire concerning the products you are bring to the Collection Center.
- Any unlabeled items will be accepted but an additional questionnaire may be required


 Buy fewer disposable items to save money and resources.


 Recycle plastic shopping bags at stores.


 Shredded office paper should be bagged separately. Participate in the "White Bag" Program. SCSWA provides bulk recycling bags to churches, schools, and businesses to deposit white paper in order to promote increased collection and recycling of white paper wastes. This program is offered at no cost!

 Donate unwanted clothes, toys and household goods to a charitable organization or homeless shelter.

 Compost your kitchen and garden waste at home. This could reduce your waste by 25% and fertilize soil in your garden.

 Buy products that have less packaging.

 When shopping take your own reusable shopping bags.

 Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Rebuy! People are recycling, companies are collecting the materials and making new products from those materials. Buy products made from recycled materials.
