

Sac City Parks Alcohol Use Policy

Rented Buildings/Structures

All State, local laws and ordinances regarding the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be strictly complied with. No beer, wine, or liquor shall be exchanged for consideration in money or money's worth. No person under 21 years of age shall be served, furnished with, or consume any alcoholic beverage on the premises. Beer, wine, and liquor shall not be served or consumed between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Any intoxicated person on the premises shall be reported to the Sac City Police Department and will be subject to arrest and criminal prosecution. This is renter's responsibility.

Beer, wine, and liquor are permitted inside the building. Beer, wine, and liquor are prohibited outside of any rented park structure.

Checking I.D.'s is a requirement and is the person or organization's responsibility. Any City Officer or on/off-duty peace officer shall have the right to gain access to the premise for law enforcement purposes.

Alcohol Use Deposits for Rented Buildings/Structures

Anyone wishing to rent City Park Building/Structures and have alcoholic beverages available for consumption shall deposit \$200 in addition to the mandated regular deposits. An alcohol deposit shall be handled in the same manner as any other rental deposit.

Campgrounds

All State, local laws and ordinances regarding the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be strictly complied with. No beer, wine, [or liquor] shall be exchanged for consideration in money or money's worth. No person under 21 years of age shall be served, furnished with, or consume any alcoholic beverage on the premises. Alcoholic beverages shall not be served or consumed between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00am. Any intoxicated person on the premises shall be reported to the Sac City Police Department and will be subject to arrest and criminal prosecution. Individuals renting campsite are responsible for their own actions and the actions of their guests.
