

City of Sac City Special Deer Hunting RULES, PROCEDURES AND ETHICS

- 1. You must complete the application specifying which property or properties you will hunt and have written permission from all landowners before a license will be issued. This license is only valid on the private land specified on the application. Respect private property!
- 2. You must carry your license and a copy of the approved application with you at all times in the field.
- 3. No bow may be used within 600 feet of any residence without the written permission of the landowner. Keep all bows cased while walking to and from your stand. All stands must be at least 25 yards from all trails, roads, buildings, etc. unless you have written permission from the landowner.
- 4. All shots must be taken from a stand. Know your effective range and do not shoot beyond that range. Recommended shots are 25 yards or less. Take only high percentage shots to avoid wounding deer.
- 5. Do not stalk or drive deer.
- 6. Be sure what is down range of your stand and make every effort to retrieve your arrow.
- 7. You must report to a city police officer within 12 hours if you are unable to locate a wounded deer. (See phone numbers below.)
- 8. Use proper field dressing techniques. Do not leave entrails in a conspicuous location.
- 9. Report any violators to the DNR conservation officers. (See phone numbers below.)
- 10. You must have in your possession a valid Iowa hunting license and habitat stamp as well as the special deer license.
- 11. A bow hunting education/safety course is highly recommended. Should classes be offered by DNR, successful completion of the class will be a requirement.
- 12. If you harvest a deer you must complete the report card and send it to the DNR conservation officer within 24 hours.
- 13. Remove yourself from any harassment situation immediately and report the incident to a DNR conservation officer.
- 14. This license is valid only within the area identified on application from October _____, 20___ to January _____, 20___.
- 15. The applicant, by submitting the application to the City of Sac City, acknowledges and agrees that applicant will hold harmless and indemnify the City of Sac City, its employees, agents and officers, as well as defend and pay all costs associated with any claim arising out of, or because of, the granting of this application by the City of Sac City including its employees, agents and officers.
