

## **Burning Ordinance**

Open burning of yard waste is permitted from April 1-May 31 and again from October 1-November 30. Open burning will be allowed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday **UNLESS THERE IS A COUNTY WIDE BURN BAN!** No burning is allowed if the winds and gusts exceed 20 mph. The City picks up yard waste every 1st and 3rd Monday. Residents will still need to purchase red yard waste tags. You can also take your yard waste to the landfill free of charge throughout the year.
