Pipeline Purpose and Reliability

Sac City Municipal Gas System is dedicated to the safe operation and delivery of natural gas to its customers. We are continually updating our distribution system, meters, and regulators in an effort to keep our system ready for the demands of our commercial or winter heating loads. With safety being our number one concern, our locally owned gas system is able to meet the needs of our customers. We educate our customers on recognizing the odor of natural gas, raise awareness of buried natural gas pipelines, the symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning, protection of our meter sets and problems with certain flexibility appliance connectors. We help excavators understand the steps that they can take to prevent third party damage and respond properly if they cause damage to our pipelines.

Gas Damage Prevention Awareness

To Prevent Accidents:

- Follow manufacturer's instruction with all gas appliances
- Have your gas appliances installed, serviced, and repaired by professionals
- Keep chimney flues and vents for appliances clean and in good repair
- Keep areas around your gas water heater and furnace clean
- Teach your family members what to do if they smell gas

The Nose Knows! Natural gas is odorless in its natural state-that's why SCMU adds an odorant so you can detect gas leaks. The smell warns you that natural gas is leaking from a pilot light that's turned off, a burner valve that's partially turned on, or from something else. If you smell gas, leave the building immediately and call SCMU at 662-7359 from another location. Natural gas is explosive if it comes in contact with a spark or flame. Avoid anything that might produce sparks, such as touching electrical switches, using the phone, opening or closing windows, or smoking.

Consumer Confidence Report: Annually, the City of Sac City is required to inform our customers about the water we drink. A consumer Confidence Report (CCR) on the water in Sac City will be published in the newspaper in May. If you wish to have a copy, you may request one at the City Office at 662-7593 or stop by between 7:00 a.m. & 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. It will also be on our website saccity.city under the Water Department tab. The City of Sac City and the water department look forward to serving your needs in the future. Please call the city at 662-7593 or the water plant at 662-4915 if you have any questions.

HOMEOWNERS—Make sure you keep your property mowed, trimmed and free of weeds. If the city has to take care of this, property owners will be assessed any costs. Also, please keep your grass clippings out of the street! Thank you!

Burning Ordinance

Open burning of yard waste is permitted from April 1-May 31 and again from October 1-November 30. Open burning will be allowed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday **UNLESS THERE IS A COUNTY WIDE BURN BAN!** No burning is allowed if the winds and gusts exceed 20 mph. The City picks up yard waste every 1st and 3rd Monday. Residents will still need to purchase red yard waste tags (city office, Food Pride, or Sac City Hardware). You can also take your yard waste to the landfill free of charge throughout the year. If you have any questions, contact the City Office at 662-7593.
