PROPERTY OWNERS: When/if you need to replace a sidewalk, make sure you pick up a building permit application from the city **EVEN IF THE SIDEWALK IS THE SAME SIZE!** Also, before building anything, fill out a building permit application and have it approved **BEFORE** starting the process!!!
